The Montgomery County Environmental Learning Center is a sustainability education facility featuring hands-on, interactive exhibits. This facility is LEED Silver certified, which means it was built with sustainability in mind.

Students can play games, watch trucks move trash on our solid waste tipping floor, and learn how to make a difference in our community through resource conservation. Schools, community groups, businesses and professional organizations are encouraged to schedule a free guided tour of the facility or host meetings and events at the site.

The Montgomery County Environmental Learning Center also provides free outreach opportunities for local schools and groups. From classroom presentations and mascot appearances, to expert speakers on recycling, litter prevention, wastewater treatment and water conservation, our staff is here to help!

FREE DAILY SERVICES for Montgomery County Residents

Residential Tires

Up to 10 scrap tires per year can be disposed of at no cost, with proof of residency. Any tires in excess of 10 are charged by weight. Tires are accepted with or without rims.

Please note that transporting more than 10 scrap tires without appropriate state registration is a felony.



Yard Waste



Clean, separated organic material in loose, bulk form or in paper yard bags. Any yard waste in plastic bags or mixed with trash will be charged a disposal fee.

Accepted Material

- Grass Clippings
- Brush/branches
- Leaves
- Other organic material

Items Not Accepted

- Food waste
- Sod
- Loose soil or dirt



Post Consumer Recyclables

*Please do not bag recyclables

Bottles, Jars and Cans

- Aluminium cans
- Plastic bottles, jugs, tubs and cups
- Steel cans (including empty aerosol cans)

Glass Containers

- Glass bottles and jars (all colors)

Corrugated Cardboard Boxes

Mixed Paper

- All types

- Buckets

Household Hazardous Waste

Winter Hours (November - February)
First Tuesday of every month
1 - 7 p.m.

Summer Hours (March - October)
Every Tuesday of the month
1 - 7 p.m.

Proof of residency required.

Accepted Items

- Computers (whole systems or parts)
- Radios, televisions, VCRs
- Speakers, CD/DVD players, receivers
- Telephones/cell phones
- Answering machines
- Scanners, 2-way radios
- Microwaves

Items Not Accepted

- Large appliances
- CDs/VHS tapes
- Hazardous materials
- Chemicals
- Styrofoam
- Plastic packaging materials



Accepted Items

- Oil paint
- Aerosol cans
- Yard/Pool chemicals
- Propane tanks
- Cleaners
- Gasoline

Items Not Accepted

- Explosives
- Radioactive material
- Pharmaceutical/medical waste
