HUBER HEIGHTS CHARTS BOLD FUTURE: 2025 STATE OF THE CITY ADDRESS SET FOR JUNE 9

HUBER HEIGHTS, OH - From booming development to major infrastructure upgrades, the City of Huber Heights is setting the stage for an ambitious future. On **Monday, June 9 at 6:00 PM**, Mayor Jeff Gore will deliver the **2025 State of the City Address** at **City Hall (6131 Taylorsville Road)** - a key moment to outline the City's progress and vision.

In a year marked by growth and revitalization, Mayor Gore will reflect on the City's notable accomplishments, introduce major projects currently underway, and highlight what lies ahead for residents and local businesses. The address is open to the public and designed to engage the community in the City's forward momentum.

- A look at fiscal stability milestones, including the City's **30th consecutive financial reporting award**
